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Modern English options

Scanty and undeveloped before the 12th century, English took shape by the early 15th century into a beautiful and powerful literary language used in government offices, schools and courts. It was soon recognized as the state language. During the period of mass emigration of the British to America, English quickly acquired international importance, dividing into territorial branches.

Modern English has several regional variations - British, American, Canadian, Australian, New Zealand, and others. The most widely used among them are two main varieties - British English, numbering several dozen dialects, and American English, which today rightfully occupies a dominant position in the world.

The British version of the English language is more conservative, requires strict adherence to grammatical rules, in particular, strict adherence to the correct word order in a sentence, and does not tolerate phrases abbreviations and "swallowing" word endings. Pronunciation with characteristic stretching vowels, as well as the intonation of sentences, are also significantly different. However, modern life makes its own adjustments, and the young generation of the British, keeping pace with the world linguistic trend, strives to simplify the language as much as possible.

The so-called "Royal English" is a dialect spoken by most of the UK population. However, the British Isles have dozens of other dialects, some of which have survived only in the most remote regions and are hardly used in

everyday life. These territorial variations of English are more of a symbolic historical legacy.

The American version of the English language is called "bad English" by the British and they treat it with some disdain. It is believed that this is a very simplified English at all levels of the language, which has become quite impoverished in the process of such transformations. In fact, such a transformation of the language is due to a different culture more liberated and dynamic. In America, it is impossible to imagine fluent, measured speech "through the nose" in perfectly correct English. Another pace of life and other values gave birth to another language - concise, laconic, simplified.

Features of modern English

Due to the large number of borrowings and the wide spreading territory, English has a rich vocabulary with many synonymous words. At the same time, its grammar is pretty simple, despite a sufficient number of exceptions to the rules and irregular verbs that need to be memorized. Most words are monosyllabic. Modern English punctuation is one of the easiest in the world. The difficulty is only spelling, since the spelling of English words often does not coincide with pronunciation. That is why it is customary to indicate transcription in dictionaries for each word.

The modern language is characterized by simplifications, compression of phrases, the use of slang vocabulary. Often in colloquial speech there is a disregard for the rules of grammar, the reduction of words and the "swallowing" of endings, as a result of which it is difficult for an unprepared person to perceive such speech by ear.
