Public safety is a system of public relations regulated by the rule of law in order to ensure the safety of the individual, public peace, favorable conditions for work and leisure of citizens, and the normal functioning of government agencies, and public associations. Hence, public security should be understood as the security of all public interests and public relations without total, including legal relations. The purpose of public safety is to identify, eliminate and prevent threats that may harm the public interest and relevant public relations in all areas. State and public authorities, non-governmental bodies, local public authorities, public associations, and international government are the subjects of public security.

The main sources of threats to public safety include:

- criminogenic condition;
- terrorist threat;
- extremist activity;
- Deterioration of the technical condition of transport infrastructure facilities, vehicles, and hydraulic structures
- the possibility of emergencies at nuclear and radiation hazardous facilities and hazardous production facilities;
- biological and chemical threats;
- There are serious risks of floods and other negative effects of water on the population, territory and facilities.

The decree of the President of Uzbekistan Shavkat Mirziyoyev approved the "Concept of Public Security

of the Republic of Uzbekistan" on November 30. It states that the concept of public security is an important document that defines the state policy in the field of public safety, which is one of the main directions of national security. The concept explains the basic concepts of public safety. In addition, the positions of cadets of higher military educational institutions are citizens aged 17 to 23 years, including those who paid at the age of 17 in the year of enrollment, as well as those aged 18 to 25 years, including the year of enrollment Admission of officers over 18 years of age to servicemen and conscripts without military ranks, as well as students of higher educational institutions of the Republic of Uzbekistan under 26 years of age and wishing to study in higher military educational institutions is done. University students are taught Russian, English, German, Chinese and Arabic.

Graduates of the university will receive the rank of lieutenant, a diploma of higher education and a driver's license. University graduates are assigned to various positions in the National Guard of the Republic of Uzbekistan, other systems of the Armed Forces of the Republic of Uzbekistan, law enforcement agencies and other public services.

In particular, public safety is a state of protection of society from unlawful aggression, social and ethnic conflicts, emergencies and other threats, which contributes to the sustainable development of society and the realization of human rights, freedoms and legitimate interests. In conclusion, I would like to conclude with the words of the head of our state, that the maintenance of order and public safety in the country around the world is carried out not by the army, not by the Ministry of Defense, but by separate structures.

As you know, today we are working hard to ensure public order in our country on the basis of the concept of "Safe City - Safe Country."
